

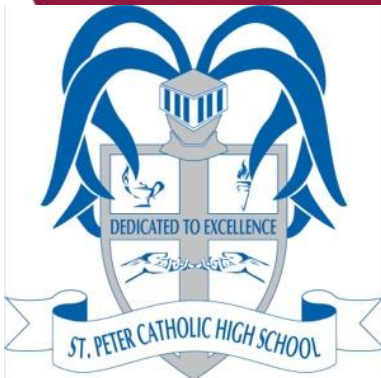

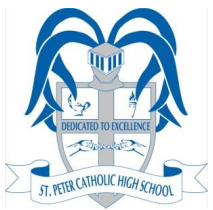

French Programs:

We offer an Immersion Program and a Core French Program.

Immersion: Students receive 850 minutes of instruction in French per week (Science, Phys.ed, Social Studies, Religion and French Language)

Core: Students receive 200 minutes of French instruction per week (French language)
